



LUSH ONLY: Body waste and toilet paper.

It is highly recommended that only ONE-PLY toilet paper be used to prevent clogging the toilet. **DO NOT FLUSH:**

- Tampons **Dust Cloths**
 - Wet Wipes Sanitary pads
 - Diapers Kleenex
- Depends Food, etc.
- When in doubt, DON'T FLUSH IT! Swiffer Cloths \triangleright

When we flush, the waste goes into a holding tank that has two pumps to expel the waste UP and OUT into the Pinellas Park sewage system. When any of the above gets flushed, it clogs the pump, overheats it and burns out the motor.


