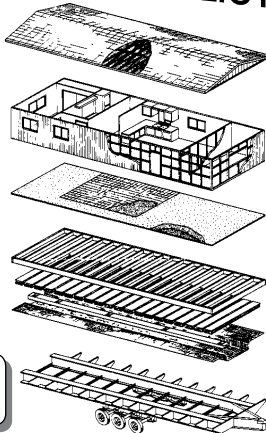

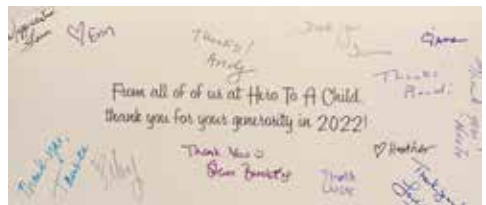


HERO TO A CHILD

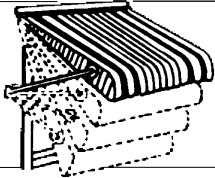

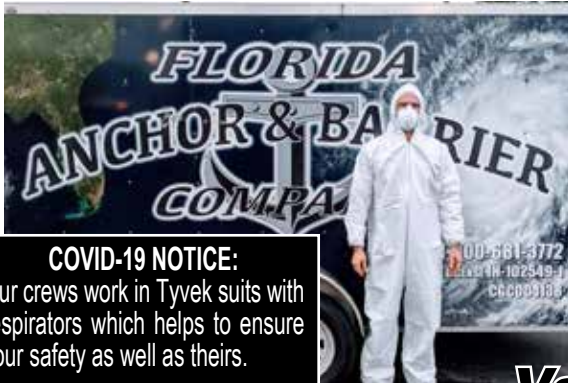
