



- 5. Do not store chairs or other loose items alongside your home these items should be stored in your shed or screen porch.
- 6. Secure your home:
- Inspect tie-down straps and anchors to prevent your home from being lifted or damaged by high winds.
- Secure loose roofing, siding, and skirting to ensure your home is weather tight.
- 7. Follow utility safety guidelines for water, electricity and gas.
- 8. Have the U.S. Post Office forward your mail.
- You can go to the post office or online to USPS.com to forward your mail.




