



PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Thas been great to see off-season activities percolating. Newly elected Social Committee President Trish Costa, Vice President Carol Eitenmiller, along with volunteers like Renee Farrington have jumped right in offering fun for all. Residents have already enjoyed a scavenger hunt, great food at the Cinco de Mayo potluck celebration, and bingo with reusable cards. A Memorial Day cookout is in the works. Thank you to all for your efforts!

Keep an eye out for postings on our" Sunset Palms 3401" Facebook page for all Social Committee updates and fun photos. If you are not already signed up to receive Social Event email notices, please contact: SunsetPalmsActivities@gmail.com to be added to the activities-specific distribution list.

Our new Clubhouse speakers have been installed, and the pool speakers have been upgraded. We now offer poolside Sirius radio music, without commercial interruption, for your listening pleasure. Thank you to Alan Arsenault and Wilfred MacEachern for your sound system expertise and to all our talented carpenters who helped retrofit the stage for the new speakers in the Clubhouse. We will next upgrade electricity access on the stage after which finish work around the speakers will be accomplished.

The Board of Directors approved the purchase of an 8x40 ft. shipping/storage container to be installed by the dumpster out at the lake. Work was accomplished this month to identify property boundaries, and quotes have been obtained for a cement pad for installation. The fencing will be repaired and connected to the container after project completion. A special shoutout and thank you goes to Terry Densmore for his vision and preliminary planning along with our Infrastructure committee chair, Gerard Mahon and members: Greg Jackson, and Kevin Lawrence.

Our custom Clubhouse storm shutters are being manufactured to specifications. Installation is expected at the end of June at the earliest. The shuffleboard court enclosure and window replacement work are on the schedule with ASC Aluminum for a September/October start. The Board of Directors approved the additional expense of the revised Property Services GC quote for the Wal-Mart Gate/Replacement Fencing at the Oleander Gate initiative. This project will take place in Fall 2025, with design details provided in advance. Meanwhile, efforts are being made to obtain lift station redesign quotes as well as redesign of the two water mains that run over the canal.

We are preparing for the installation of the two new power generators. A 250 gal. propane tank will be installed by the lake to power the back lift station. Unfortunately, the Clubhouse & front lift station generator work is dependent on running a new TECO gas line, which the vendor is not available to do until late July.

Our Vision committee, led by Pat Osmond and Karen Harding, spent many hours this season with volunteers working on planning, quoting and obtaining project approvals for electrical, plumbing and kitchen equipment upgrades for the Clubhouse. Purchases have been made, and

contracts have been executed. When you return next season, there will be new water heaters efficiently supporting the bathroom and kitchen needs, a Clubhouse water conditioning system, two commercial kitchen sinks/faucets, microwave, range vent hoods, a convection oven and replacement overhead lighting in the kitchen after which new counter tops will finish off the initiative. Thank you to our many residents who offered expertise with this effort. It was amazing and we have been blessed with your kindness.

And last but not least, while we hoped discussions regarding multi-use courts could happen before the end of high season, we did not hear back from vendors in a timely manner and our Vision volunteers were keenly focused on the Clubhouse initiatives right up to the season's end. Please understand this effort is not forgotten. A significant amount of information gathering has taken place. This project will be the next Vision Committee focus as previously identified as Priority #3, and our residents will have the opportunity to participate.

Our thoughts and prayers go out to those in need.

- 1. Prepare a Hurricane Disaster Plan
- Plan where you will go if evacuation is necessary, a friend or relative's home or a nearby shelter. Include a meeting place for family members.
- Add Emergency Contacts numbers and addresses to your phone.
- Make a list of any medications and dosages for each member of your household, as well as the doctor's contact information.
- Create a list of Banking information and Credit Card numbers
- Keep your motor vehicle gas tank filled Gas may not be readily available if you need to evacuate.
- Put together a Go Bag
- 2. Assemble a Go Bag in an easy-to-carry container such as a backpack
- Emergency contact and meeting place information for your household and a small regional

- Put copies of important documents (photo IDs, insurance cards, social security cards, birth certificates, banking information list, medication list, etc.) in a waterproof, portable container or bag.
- Cash in small denominations.
- Extra set of house and car keys.
- Cell phone chargers including one that can be used without electricity, such as a car charger and an extra cell phone battery.
- Flashlight, emergency radio, and batteries.
- Personal items such as soap, toothbrush and toothpaste, feminine hygiene products, hand sanitizer, disinfectant wipes, aspirin, etc.
- Change of clothing including sturdy, comfortable shoes and rain gear.
- Bottled water and non-perishable foods.
- Pet care items and food.
- 3. As a Storm Approaches
- Stay informed through radio and TV broadcasts.
- If told to evacuate, do so immediately.
- Bring loose, lightweight items inside.
- Anchor objects that are unsafe to bring inside, such as grills.
- Check on friends, neighbors, and relatives. Assist them with their preparation.
- If you are going to an evacuation shelter, pack what you will need for several days, including your Go Bag, blankets, pillows, and medical equipment.
- Tell friends and neighbors where you are going.
