




PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Thope you are finding ways to enjoy the summer sun and fun as we saunter into the heat of July here in Florida. It is time to repay the generosity of our neighbors at Golden Gate by extending the availage.



Legenerosity of our neighbors at Golden Gate by extending the availability of our pool for their use while their pool is being worked on. We expect to welcome them beginning in August for approximately 6 weeks. Please show them the same kind hospitality we experienced in their park last year when we were in need.

If you are looking for activity to escape the sun, replacement dart boards have been received, and a foldable ping pong table is on order for clubhouse use. If availability frees up, the table should arrive in July. We also received a new piece of exercise equipment in the gym at the end of the high season (a recumbent elliptical machine). Thank you to the Rodockers for their kind donation! Be sure to check it out!

And if you'd prefer to relax, read and stay up to date, check out the much-improved Sunset Palms website layout (in the Resident's section). Newly designed pages now facilitate a simple click of the specific committee reports and board meeting minutes you are interested in versus scrolling through lengthy lists of documents. Thank you to Maggie Stokes whose work with our web designer accomplished this improvement.

We should be seeing the installation of our custom clubhouse storm shutters right about the time this July newsletter is published. We'll be asking the board to replace the worn-out wicker furniture on the front patio to complete the exterior update.

Installation of the shipping container for storage at the lake is pending while we obtain quotes, as recommended by our audience at our board meeting, to include laying a cement foundation for both the dumpster area and the shipping container pad.

We are prepping for the installation of the two new back-up power generators. Electrical Engineering designs have been achieved. The smaller of the two generators has been delivered and is pending permitting and pouring of a cement pad to facilitate the back lift station generator installation which will be powered by a 250 gal. propane tank to be set. The clubhouse & front lift station generator work is dependent on running a new TECO gas line, which is scheduled for late July. The area has been cleared up by our maintenance staff in preparation and a stump will need to be removed. Quotes are being obtained to secure the laundry area from non-resident use and will move to the board for review and approval. The purchase of a larger commercial washer will also be part of the improvements.

Work on clubhouse upgrades is underway. Our new audio speakers are delivering a much-improved sound experience in the clubhouse and at the pool. Two new water heaters were installed. New commercial kitchen sinks are in place. Thank you to our maintenance staff who took on this work. Final plumbing is pending the addressing of refurbished kitchen counters and a change in the heights of the faucet sprayers. The new convection oven is in place. Vent hoods, a microwave,

PARK UPDATES



Then you receive this newsletter, we will be starting July, and the following projects will be underway or completed.

- New signs have been added to the front walls, a new sign has been installed at the park entrance, faded "Slow Down" signs have been replaced, and "Please Do Not Park On Sidewalks" signs have been placed throughout the park.
- Our vendor was scheduled for June 25th to repair the pool fencing, the fencing at the maintenance building, and the Oleander fence.
- The Clubhouse will be sporting new impact shutters, and we will have armor screens to protect the windows instead of having to put up plywood during hurricane season. The installation is scheduled for June 30th, July 1st and July 2nd.
- Maintenance has continued replacing water risers behind homes where needed.

Remember that Hurricane Season started on June 1st - please be prepared and stay safe.

- Bring loose, lightweight items inside.
- Keep carports free of clutter.



I was just talking with Bet. She was asking how we are doing. My reply, "It's quiet!"



For someone who has been a very busy on the go guy, I find myself leaning into quiet. Matter of fact, in this season of life I've sought to become more comfortable with being quiet. It's not my nature.


