




Recommended Items to Include in a Basic Emergency Supply Kit

- ☐ Water and non-perishable food for several days
- ☐ Extra cell phone battery or charger
- ☐ Battery-powered or hand crank radio that can receive NOAA Weather Radio tone alerts and extra batteries
- ☐ Flashlight and extra batteries
- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- ☐ Whistle to signal for help
- ☐ Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation Non-sparking wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- ☐ Can opener (if kit contains canned food)
- ☐ Local maps



Additional Items to Consider Adding to an Emergency Supply Kit:

- ☐ Prescription medications and glasses
- ☐ Infant formula and diapers
- \square Pet food, water and supplies for your pet
- ☐ Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification and bank account records in a portable waterproof container
- ☐ Cash and change
- ☐ Emergency reference material such as a first aid book or information from www.ready.gov
- ☐ Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person.
- ☐ Complete change of clothing including a long sleeved shirt, long pants and sturdy shoes.
- ☐ Fire Extinguisher Matches in a waterproof container Feminine supplies, personal hygiene items and hand sanitizer
- ☐ Mess kits, Paper cups, plates and disposable utensils, paper towels
- ☐ Paper and pencil Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children

'm sorry but I cannot come to the phone right now! I am on vacation and will return your call upon my return." Well, I wish that was the case, but requirements continue with no sensitivity to the season.

The installation of the shutters on the clubhouse is almost complete and the generator project is beginning. An updated Wind Mitigation report, recognizing the protection of the clubhouse windows, should help reduce a portion of the cost of insurance coverage for 2026. The board hopes these improvements will better serve us should we encounter severe storms in the future. Budget planning for 2026 is right around the corner and we are preparing for an updated Reserve Study. This engineering review of our facilities quantifies the condition of our assets and solidifies a plan for proactive maintenance. The identified maintenance requirements transition into a phased approach which in turn drives annual expense upon which we base a portion of the coming year's budget needs. This is just one piece of the overall funding requirements each year but an important one.

Feedback from preliminary meetings with our residents regarding the potential outdoor activities center was appreciated. A summary report will be available on the website in the Vision VIP Committee section for your reference; meanwhile, additional information is being worked on as a result of these discussions.

A reminder that Golden Gate residents are invited to use our pool while theirs is being worked on, effective the first week of August for approximately 6 weeks. We hope you enjoy the opportunity to meet and make new friends in your own backyard.

Our thoughts and prayers go out to those who have lost loved ones or who are facing health challenges. We are better together, and we care.

MANAGER'S CORNER

GUESTS

his month I want to remind residents about several Park Rules regarding guests and the use of the recreation facilities.

- All Guests staying more than two nights must register at the Park Office on arrival and obtain a temporary parking permit to be displayed when parking overnight in the park.
- A Guest is a person whose stay does not exceed thirty (30) total days in any twelve (12) month period, unless the Board of Directors approves, in writing, a longer period.
- No Guests will be allowed to stay in a unit unless one of the residents is present.
- Guests are the entire responsibility of their Resident host and must comply with Park Rules and Regulations.
- No pets may be brought in with Guests.
- Guest parking is allowed around the Clubhouse with an appropriate permit obtained from the park office.
- No visiting gasoline powered motorcycles are permitted in the park.
- It is the resident's responsibility to ensure that all guests under the age of eighteen (18) years of age are supervised by an adult when using the recreation facilities.

POOL

- The pool is open Sunday through Saturday from 8:00 am to 11 pm.
- There is no lifeguard on duty the use of the pool and Jacuzzi is at your own risk.
- Rules are posted at the pool and the Jacuzzi.
- No one under the age of eighteen (18) is permitted on the pool deck, in the pool, or in the Jacuzzi without adult supervision.
- Adult-only hours are from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm and 7:00 pm to 8:00 pm.
- No one under the age of eighteen is allowed in the pool area during adult hours.
- No diving or jumping is allowed.

Please follow the rules of the association to maintain harmony in the community.

Identity Theft

Warning signs of identity theft

- · Bills for items you did not buy
- · Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- Denials of loan applications
- · Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The fraud department at your credit card issuers, bank, and other places where you have accounts

How to protect yourself from identity theft

- Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- · Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.

Imposter Scam

The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are **someone** in **authority**. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- Scammers may also pretend to be from your bank or a company you do business with. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with your account.

Please reach out to Trish Costa, President (trish614c@yahoo.com) or Carol Eitenmiller, Vice President (cmeitenmiller@yahoo.com) for pre-approval before requesting space in the Clubhouse. If a private party/event is requested, paperwork will need to be completed with the office staff, and a refundable deposit is required. Private events are subject to cancelation if use of the clubhouse is needed for association events.

The Clubhouse is for your enjoyment. Don't forget that the library has books for you to check out. The exercise room has equipment and a pool table. Dart boards are there for your use. A Ping-Pong table will be available soon. Come on down and have some fun!






