



MANAGER'S CORNER

ooking back and moving forward...

I am sharing this article with you because I was so excited that the Park's fencing that was damaged during the storms finally got replaced. I have been impatient with the fencing company and the contractors who have not been able to get to our repairs as quickly as we would have anticipated after last year's storms.

It is hard to believe that it has been a year since Hurricanes Helene (September 26, 2024) and Milton (October 10, 2024), caused catastrophic damage to Pinellas County. Two powerful storms that impacted the residents of Pinellas County in two very different ways.

Helene's storm surge caused widespread flooding along the beaches and low-lying areas of Pinellas County resulting in fatalities and the destruction of homes and businesses, and damage to roads, parks, and the beaches.

I will never forget seeing the cars that were parked in the garage under my building floating in the water and banging into each other and the walls of the building as the water came up higher and higher, or the next morning when there was no sea wall, no grass, bushes, asphalt drives, or Gulf Boulevard – everything was buried and covered in sand.

The arrival of Milton's high winds (gusts of 80 - 100 mph were reported in Pinellas County) and rainfall of over 18 inches in St. Petersburg and Clearwater Beach, added to the destruction that Helene had caused just two weeks earlier causing widespread debris everywhere. The winds were so strong that the roof of Tropicana Field in St. Petersburg was ripped off.

More flooding, more damage, more debris along the streets. The excessive rainfall from Milton caused the entire first floor of our condominium building (which is 10 feet above sea level) to flood.

My husband and I took a drive along Clearwater Beach last weekend and it was sad to see the visible damage to the beach and the homes there. The debris (sofas, cribs, pictures, mattresses, cabinets, etc.) that was piled along the streets is gone, but the shells of houses remain; many of them for sale. Repairs have started on the roof of Tropicana Field, but the aftermath of the storms is still evident. It is not the same and will take a long time to become a new normal.
