Important Changes for This Year's Yard Sale

River cruising has a certain charm that sets it apart. It's scenic, cultural, comfortable, and beautifully paced - perfect for travelers who want to experience a destination rather than simply sail past it. 1. Castle Views



KITCHEN IMPROVEMENTS AT OUR CLUBHOUSE

Submitted by Pat Osmond

In the fall and spring of 2024 and 2025, a group of residents volunteered to participate in a focus group to determine improvements to the kitchen in our clubhouse. These individuals had experience in planning and preparing food for events for residents of Sunset Palms. Both the Social Club and Pancake Breakfast had representation on the working group. Opportunity to participate was open to all residents. The focus group reported to the Vision Implementing Priorities Committee.

The priority concern was the stove. The burners were not working properly and there was a need for increased capacity in the oven. The burners on the stove were fixed and proved to be working at the next two events that were held at the clubhouse. Through research and visiting two restaurant supply businesses in the area, it was determined that the current stove has a high rating for reliability.

Group recommendation and consensus was to purchase a convection oven. The convection oven allows us to heat and/or cook food at a lower temperature; allows us to have food on multiple oven racks, and the one we purchased is a ventless oven. For example, if you want to cook several trays of macaroni and cheese, the trays can be put on four shelves and will all cook at the same time and will not need to be rotated in the oven. In addition, the oven is at chest height, thus improving ergonomics and safety (no bending to lift foods out of the oven). Two of the members of the working group had work experience with a similar oven. The oven is for use by all residents who are preparing foods for any approved activity that is for residents of Sunset Palms. The oven was used to help prepare food for our recent Thanksgiving dinner. The manual for the operation of the oven will be kept in the kitchen for reference.

Two new sinks (with drain boards) and faucets have been installed. One sink is deeper to facilitate cleaning of large pots.

Lighting in the ceilings has been replaced with pot lights. Improved lighting for area over the sinks has been purchased and will be installed.




